Forgot something at home?

Due to the LARGE size of our campus and the distance children have to walk to the office, we will not be calling students out of class for dropped off items. Instead, students will stop by the office on their way to lunch. Please be sure to send your student each morning with needed jackets, water bottles, chrome books and lunchbags.

Riding a bike, scooter, skateboard to school?

We have a bike rack in front of our school for convenience. It will be locked during school hours from 8:15-3:10 for safety. An additional bike lock is not needed but can be used if desired.

Dismissal

It was a great ending to a great week. Our pick is completed by 3:30 and people are finding thier groove! Here is a reminder of the procedures.

PK/TK/K Dismissal

Drivers

- *Please put Pink or Red colored sign in your window. ONLY these two colors are allowed in the Kinder drop off area to the right when you enter the driveway.
- *Teachers will assist with putting students in cars. Please teach your students how to buckle or unbuckle themselves. Parents remain in cars.

- *Teachers will walk students to the breezeway for parent walking pick up
- *Parents will wait behind the cones outside of the gate for students to be released.

Grades 1-5

All students will exit through the Breezeway.

Drivers:

- *Grade levels are color coded (TK: Pink, K: Red, 1st: Orange, 2nd: Yellow, 3rd: Green, 4th: Blue, 5th: Purple)
- *Parents will have a piece of assigned colored construction paper in their car window with the student's first name and teacher name.
- *Students will SIT in assigned grade level (5th closest to Kinder and 1st closest to Breezeway gate).
- *If there are multiple students in a family, the siblings will SIT with the youngest student's grade and parents will use the youngest child's color paper with all students' names.
- *Staff will be on duty to call student's names, wave cars to fill up the Pick Up Loop, and to help with student supervision while names are being called.
- *When students are called, they will walk to the car as the cars fill up the Drive Up Loop. (Parents will NOT stop to pick up students where they are.)
- *Parents must remain in their car at all times.

Walkers:

- *All walkers will exit the Breezeway and walk to the right.
- *Solo student walkers will exit the campus. (They can go left if they walk up Richland Road).
- *Parents will wait behind a marked off area to the right.
- *Students who are being picked up by Walk Up Parents will walk to meet parents behind the waiting area.
- *The area in front of the Breezeway Gate must remain clear of parents in order for students to safely exit campus.
- *There will be a teacher assigned on duty to monitor the students being picked up on foot by parents.
- *Parents will meet their students to the left of the Multipurpose to await

KOC:

*Students going to KOC will exit the gate and walk to the entrance of the KOC classrooms where they will be met by staff.

Boys and Girls Club:

*Students going to Boys and Girls Club will enter the lobby of the MPR and meet staff in the MPR room.
